

Ric Rac Christmas Tree Card

Materials:

- ½ m of 5 mm width ric rac
- 1 sheet of A4 card
- 1 sheet of A5 card

Optional:

- Metallic star stud
- Metallic square stud
- Gold/silver ric rac

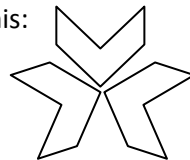
Supplies:

- PVC craft glue
- Double-sided tape
- Craft scissors
- Craft knife, metal ruler and cutting board



How to:

1. Using the template, make a print out the guidelines for the Christmas tree-tiers on the A5 card. Make sure that the paper size is A5 in your print settings.
2. Trim around the printed card along the crop marks, using a craft knife and metal ruler
3. Cut the ric rac into nine segments. Start with a 1 triangle segment, then a segment of 2 triangles, and so on, until you have a segment of 9 triangles.
4. Glue the segments onto the A5 card using the guidelines to form a pyramid.
5. To fashion the star using ric rac, cut 3 single segments of ric rac and glue them with the pointed ends facing towards the centre like this:



6. Cut one single segment to use as the stump of the tree.
7. Alternatively, use the star and square studs at the top and bottom of the tree.
8. Fold the A4 card in half.
9. Attach the ric rac card to the folded A4 card using double-sided tape.
10. Your Christmas Tree card is now complete!
